

TEAM BC LT Update #3 November 2018

Welcome to the third update for the Racing to Red Deer process for TEAM BC Long Track. Since the second update in February 2018 several important things have occurred. The Calgary Oval experienced some issues with their refrigeration system in February, forcing the cancellation of 2 originally scheduled Racing to Red Deer (R2RD) qualifying events in March, Oval Grand Prix 2018 and Canada Cup #4/Oval Finale 2018. Two additional events were added to the qualification process, Summer Classic 2018 (July) and Oval International 2018 (October). Unfortunately, the repairs at the Calgary Oval took longer than expected, and the Summer Classic 2018 event was also cancelled. Two of the three remaining qualifying events have occurred since that time, being Fall Classic 2018 (September) and Oval International 2018 (October), leaving one R2RD qualifying event remaining, CanAm 2018.

In early October the TEAM BC Short Track Selection Trials were held in Red Deer, at the Gary W. Harris Canada Games Centre. The competition was run as part of the Canada Winter Games test event and gave all the athletes, families, coaches and officials an opportunity to see the venue in advance of the Canada Games. Following some exciting racing, the final TEAM BC ST ranking lists have been released via the R2RD Short Track Newsletter, Issue 8. Final team announcements will be made in mid-December, following the TEAM BC Long Track selection process.

A reserved number of Games passes, week 1 and week 2 sport passes, Waskasoo family passes and Opening and Closing Ceremonies tickets are available for Provincial/Territorial teams (including sales to participants, as well as friends and family) **now until January 1, 2019.** A code is provided to teams to access this allotment of tickets and to share with stakeholders.

Passes purchased during the pre-sale are delivered by mail starting in October 2018 up until Games time. Opening and Closing Ceremonies tickets may be printed at home or mailed with the passes.

If you have not yet participated in a qualifying Long Track event, it is not too late to add yourself to the list of skaters pre-qualified to participate in the TEAM BC Long Track Selection Trials in December 2018. There is one event remaining, CanAm in Calgary from November 30 – December 2. As a reminder, in order to qualify from this event to attend the TEAM BC Long Track Selection Trials in Fort St. John from December 7 - 9 athletes need to complete a minimum of 3 different Olympic-style distances within one competition.
