

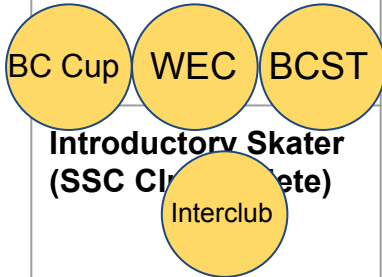

Membership Categories

Category	Structure	SSC Fee	SSBC Fee
National Athlete	Annual membership for a skater who participates in Senior or Junior Canadian Championships, Canada Cups or the Canada Winter Games.	\$65	\$115
Provincial Athlete	Annual membership for a skater who participates in the Canadian Youth Championships, provincial championships and/or inter-provincial competitions.	\$45	\$95
Club Athlete	Annual membership for a skater who participates in recreational and introductory programming (Learn to Skate programs, etc.) and/or participates in regional or club level competitions only.	\$8	\$75
Introductory Skater (SSC Club Athlete)	Annual membership for a skater who participates in an introductory program such as "Learn to Speed Skate". Program length is a maximum of 10 sessions per membership year and may include entry in a club meet or race.	\$8	\$17
Try Speed Skating	Event membership for a skater who only participates in one special event, such as, but not limited to an open house, festival or school event. Event duration may not exceed two days. A person may register for more than one special event.	\$0	\$0



Membership Categories

Category	Structure	SSC Fee	SSBC Fee
Coach	Annual membership for an individual who actively participates in the delivery of speed skating programs and/or competitions and identifies as In-training, Trained or Certified in an NCCP coaching context.	\$7	\$19
Official	Annual membership for an individual who actively participates in the delivery of speed skating competitions and/or events and has completed a minimum of Level 1 training in a provincial, territorial or national officials' development program.	\$7	\$19
Volunteer	Annual membership for an individual who actively supports the delivery of activities and competitions for the betterment of speed skating in their community and beyond.	\$0	\$0

Best Practices

- **Multiple Categories:** If members participate in multiple categories, they must register into each category (add each membership to cart). Most expensive membership category will be charged.
- **Insurance:** Only completed memberships in IceReg are valid for insurance purposes. Memberships are not retroactive.
- **Privacy:** Collect required information only and consider privacy laws
 - Collect medical information such as pertinent history and allergies. Pertinent information should be shared with coaches.
 - BC Services Card number, doctor names, etc. should not be collected.
- **Programming:** Simplify club programming requirements according to registration categories.
- **Payment Groups:** Available by request for members using JumpStart, Kidsport, etc.

SSBC Competition	Provincial level competitions (Championships, BC Cups, BC Games, etc.)	Required	Required
SSBC Event	Provincial level events (Academy, GenBC, officials/coaches clinics/workshops, professional development, AGM, etc.)	Required	Required
Club Competition	Club or interclub competitions	Required	Optional*

*Payment may still be required by participant for membership category upgrade
