

Policy:

Competitions Committee: Terms of Reference

Board Approved: April 23, 2023

Current

- 1. The Competitions' Committee shall consist of:
 - a. The Chair or person acting as Chair.
 - b. Representatives of the Athlete Development Committee; the Coaching Development Committee; the Officials Development Committee; the Sport Development Committee and up to a maximum of two other persons.
 - c. The Technical Director or Sport Administrator will sit on the committee in an advisory capacity.
 - d. If a SSBC member is appointed to Speed Skating Canada's Competitions

 Committee then that member where possible, will be an ex-officio member of this

 committee in an advisory capacity.
- 2. The Competitions' Committee will be responsible for:
 - a. overseeing all SSBC provincial competitions by liaising with the host clubs and committees;
 - b. ensuring that the host clubs and committees adhere to the Competitions and Events Policies, Procedures and Regulations;
 - c. presenting plans for the upcoming season to SSBC Board of Directors by the Spring planning meeting.

Updated

Competitions Committee

The Competitions Committee is an Operating Committee of the Board.

Mandate and Objectives

The Competitions Committee is a multidisciplinary committee which works in an advisory capacity to support competition alignment in the province.

Composition, Appointment and Roles

A representative from each of the Standing Committees: Athlete, Coaching, Officials and Sport Development and up to a maximum of two other SSBC members,

The Committee will choose a chair from amongst their number or the Board may appoint one,

A staff member may sit on the committee in an advisory capacity,

If an SSBC member is appointed to Speed Skating Canada's Sport Development Advisory Council Committee then that member may be an ex-officio member of this committee,

Annually, after each AGM the Standing Committees will choose a member to join the Competitions Committee.

Meetings

The Committee will review and advise on SSBC's annual Competition Bulletin,

The Committee may be required to meet on SSBC business as it arises pertaining to competitions within BC,

The Committee will meet as required throughout the year,

Quorum shall be a simple majority of members,

Voting shall be conducted as necessary in order to determine the final recommendation of the Committee.

Reporting

Minutes are to be kept of each meeting,

The Board may ask at any time for an update on the work of the Competition Committee.
