



# Zone 6 Qualification Format 2024 BC Winter Games

The 2024 BC Winter Games (BCWG) will take place in Lhtako-Quesnel on February 22-25, 2024. The speed skating event will feature short track races, hosted in Prince George. Please see the [Technical Package for Speed Skating](#) for details. Skaters must be in Division U14 (12 or 13 years old) or U16 (14 or 15 years old) as of June 30, 2023. All skaters compete at the BCWG for their [Zone](#), which is based on their place of residence. There are two methods of qualification to BCWG:

1. Qualify, via the Zone Qualification Format, for a Zone quota position (see details below)
2. Qualify into a wildcard position (see Tech Package for details).

## Zone 6 Qualification Format

Skaters qualifying for a Zone quota position (2 male and 2 female per Division, per Zone) must participate in their Zone Qualification Format (QF). The Zone QF is established by the Zone Rep (Brenda Hennigar) and the Provincial Advisor (Chris Acton, SSBC Technical Director).

The Zone 6 QF selects skaters to Zone quota positions based on the skaters' best times skated, as defined below. All times must be skated in a sanctioned competition. Manual times will have 0.2 seconds added to them in order to compare the times to electronic times.

- Personal best times skated in a SSBC sanctioned competition after Oct 1, 2023 and before December 17, 2023 will be used to determine selection of the eligible skaters for each division.
  - Submitted Personal Best times for the following distances will be used to create a combined time for ranking purposes:
    - U-14 400m and 1500m (100m track)
    - U-16 500m and 1500m (111.12m track)
- Skaters with the lowest combined times will be selected accordingly as ranked.

In the event of a tie (after the combination of 2 distances) a third distance will be added to the combined times as follows:

- U-14 1000m (100m track)
- U-16 1000m (111.12m track)

## BC Winter Games Registration

All Zone quota positions must be awarded by December 31st, 2023. Between January 1-15th, 2024, wildcard positions will be calculated and awarded by the Provincial Advisor. All skaters must be registered by the Zone Rep by the BC Winter Games registration deadline of January 22nd, 2024.
