THE BUILDER

- DEVELOP PEOPLE Be a leading PSO in BC for Coach, Official and Volunteer development.

 - Develop sufficient officials and coaches in all regions to facilitate club operations
- DEVELOP SKATERS Encourage speed skating as a sport for life through holistic, athlete-centered programming and events.

 - o Direct province-wide performance programming and development
 - Review programming annually to ensure quality
